On November 19th we are going to have a Pre-Thanksgiving Pot Luck at Pete Williams' home in Fraser. This was a lot of fun last year so we decided to do it again this year. Roast Turkey and Potatoes will be provided by Pete. Pot luck dishes and desserts will be provided by you. As with last
