The new website, launched on August 31, contains all the information we are used to seeing and more. The engine that drives it and the way that it is presented is much more user friendly and definitely less clunky than the old site. At this point, the main MBCA site is mostly completed. There will be enhancements as the months go by. It is a work in progress.

One of the really exciting enhancements will be the individual sections ability to link from and to the main MBCA site. Think of it as MBCA being the mother ship and the sections being the little boats around that mother ship with lines of communication back and forth. Administrative reports and databases will be able to be used and updated by the sections and selective individual updates will be allowed. It's quite a leap!

There is a need for you to do a little bit to register on the website. Once you get to the www.mbca.org main page, you need to get started by setting up your "LOGIN" (upper right of the opening page). Next you'll be taken to the "User Account" page where you can enter either your full email address or your member number. Under "password" you enter either your MBCA forum password or your MBCA member number all in CAPS (as in A000000). Associate members

type in the suffix letter "A" (associate) (as in A000000). After entering your username and password you will be taken to the "Profile page". Please update the information including current preferred email address, cars owned, and a digital photo of yourself. If you can't log in successfully click on the tab "Request New Password". If the MBCA database has your correct email address on file, you'll be emailed a one-time password reset link within minutes of your request.

What's out there *right now*? All of our up-coming section events and flyers - all at a click of a mouse. We have some event reports and pictures there as well.

What's *going to be* out there? In the next few months we will actually have a real website where we can house our newsletters (STARS News and Benz Scene) events and calendars. We will send you an email to let you know when new things are posted. You will be able to periodically check the site to see if there are any updates. No more lost flyers or information! It will all be there for you... and it will be in COLOR.

I never thought we'd be this far along or have accomplished as much as we have this year. We did a lot and had some fun along the way. Join us. The 21st Century is here NOW! Embrace it and sign on and join the communication revolution! We can't get there without you.
